CH-1: BASIC INFORMATION

The State Council for Technical Education (SCTE), Assam with approval from the Higher Education Department, Government of Assam vide Government Letter - e File No. 249330/6, dated 3rd April, 2024 conducts the admission process in the State Government Polytechnics of Assam on the basis of marks obtained by students in H.S.L.C. examination or equivalent Examination with Mathematics and Science as compulsory subjects.

1.1. INTRODUCTION

The State Government Polytechnics of Assam offers 3 (three) year Diploma in Engineering & Technology Programme across 26 Government Polytechnics of Assam.

1.2. AFFILIATION

The Diploma in Engineering & Technology Programme offered by the Government Polytechnics of Assam are affiliated to the **State Council for Technical Education (SCTE)**, Assam and approved by **All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)**.

1.3. NBA ACCREDITATION

National Board of Accreditation (NBA) had accredited the programmes namely Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering & Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering of Assam Engineering Institute, Guwahati from 2024-25 up to 30-6- 2027.

The candidates must pay the below-mentioned admission fees at the time of Document Verification at the institute where they get the 1st seat allotment.

- i. Rs 4650/- (Four Thousand Six Hundred Fifty only) for all candidates except for Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) category excluding examination fees, hostel rent and mess dues.
- ii. Rs 4150 /-(Four Thousand One Hundred Fifty only) for TFW candidates excluding examination fees, hostel rent and mess dues.
- iii. Registration fee of Rs. 150/- (One hundred fifty only) will have to be collected by the institution during admission and the same has to be deposited to the SCTE account by the institution.

Total fee to be paid during admission by the candidates:

- iv. **For all candidates except TFW: Rs. 4800/-**
- v. **For TFW candidate: Rs. 4300/-**

Note: The above rates are subject to change as per guidelines from Government of Assam. In addition, hostel boarders have to pay the mess dues as per the rules fixed by the Mess Committee, if any.

CH-3: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.1 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION:

For 3-Years Diploma courses in Engineering and Technology, a candidate must fulfill the following conditions: -

- a) Candidates seeking admission into 3-Year Diploma Programmes offered by SCTE, Assam must register through the portal <https://dte.assam.gov.in> as and when notified by the competent authority.
- b) **The candidate must pass the H.S.L.C. or equivalent examination with Mathematics and Science as compulsory subject in a single sitting (without grace marks in Science and Mathematics) and also have to pass individually in both theory and practical/ Internal Assessment with -**
 - * **40% marks** on Average in Mathematics and Science for General/ OBC-MOBC-NCL candidates
 - * **35% marks** on Average in Mathematics and Science for SC candidates.
 - * **33% marks** on Average in Mathematics and Science for ST Candidates.
 - * In case of Person with disabilities (PwD) required percentage is as per his/her original category
- c) In case of students from the National Institute of Open Schooling [NIOS]
 - Science & Technology may be considered in place of Science.
 - In place of Social Science other subjects with higher mark may be considered
- d) In case of Students from the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination Board [ICSE] Marks of History and Civics or Geography may be considered in place of Social Science.
- e) **NO COMPARTMENTAL CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE ADMISSION.**

3.2. AGE

Minimum age should be 16 years as on 31-12-2026. There is no upper age limit for admission. Candidates must be born on or before 31-12-2010.

3.3. PHYSICAL FITNESS

A candidate must be physically and mentally fit. Candidates will have to produce fitness Certificate at the time of admission from a registered medical practitioner (optional).

3.4. RESIDENTIAL ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must be an Indian Citizen and a Permanent Resident of Assam. Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC) must be produced at the time of Counseling. Otherwise his/her seat may be cancelled at any stage of his/her study.

3.5. ELIGIBILITY FOR SPORTS QUOTA

- The candidate must be a medal winner of State Games/ State Championships/ Tournaments organized by Assam Olympic Association/ State Sports Association/Directorate of Sports & Youth Welfare, Assam and will be decided in order of Medals of Gold/Silver/Bronze received.
- The medals received by the candidates must be within the period of last 3 years.

3.6. ELIGIBILITY FOR NCC QUOTA

Selection of candidates for NCC category would be considered in order of merit as per NCC Examination Certificate received from the Commanding Officer, National Cadets Corps or higher level to be treated as given below-

3.7. ATTENDANCE

Candidates who are allotted seats must attend classes after taking admission from the date of announcement of classes. Please refer the Counseling Guidelines as and when published.

CH-4: RESERVATION OF SEATS

(On the basis of Government of Assam letter No. ATE-62/2009/203, dated 28th November, 2017 & Ecf No. 328482//5, dated 19th July, 2023.)

Reservation of seats in the Polytechnics of Assam is made for the following categories of candidates. If any candidate fails to specify his/her category at the time of online form fill up, he/she will be considered as unreserved category. (PLEASE REFER TO TABLE-7)

- ***Candidates must note that the benefit of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is found at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document, or has furnished false, incorrect, or incomplete information, in order to avail the benefit of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from the entire admission processes. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.***

Note :-

1. The competent issuing authority of all the certificates is Government of Assam, except for Son/Daughter of Central Government Employees.
2. CGE Quota can be availed by those whose parent/s are not permanent residents of Assam and working in Assam for less than 20 years.

CH-5: APPLICATION PROCESS

5.1. APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for 3 years diploma in Government Polytechnics of Assam, the applicants must visit the DTE, Assam website <https://dte.assam.gov.in> from the notified date.

The application process may be broadly divided into the following categories:

- Registration in the online portal
- Form fill up & document upload
- Choice filling
- Payment of registration fee

Applicants will be considered for rank generation only after completion of all the steps mentioned above.

Important Note:

1. **There will be verification of the documents uploaded by the applicants after the registration and application process is over. Counselling process will start after the verification process. Applicants may receive calls/messages/emails on their registered mobile number/ email regarding clarification on any information/document uploaded by the applicant. Applicants must respond to such calls/messages/emails on time. Failing to do so may result in rejection of his application.**
2. As per the current transfer guidelines, no student is allowed to take transfer during the first year of study.
3. Though more number of choices increases the possibility of getting admitted, applicants are advised to fill up their choices wisely keeping in mind the point above.

5.2. REGISTRATION FEE

Applicants will have to pay the onetime **non-refundable** application/registration fee of **Rs. 300/- (Rupees three hundred)** plus applicable taxes, if any, online by clicking on the payment link. Application will be considered complete only when the portal reflects the payment as successful.

5.3. HELP DESK/ HELP CENTER

For any help and information, interested candidates can visit the Help Centre of their nearest Government Polytechnic. They can also contact the Central Help Desk. The details of the Central Help Desk will be provided in the online portal.

NOTE:

1. **Any changes in the above guidelines as per Govt. guidelines/AICTE guidelines from time to time will be notified accordingly.**
2. **Detailed guidelines regarding this will be issued later and will be made available in the registration and application portal.**

CH-6: COUNSELLING PROCESS

The broad outline of the process is as below:

- Allotment of seat as per eligibility, rank, caste/category, choice/preference and availability of seat,
- Acceptance of seat through the portal and download allotment letter
- Contact admission coordinator of the allotted institution and report to the allotted institute on specified date
- Physical document verification at the allotted institution
- Admission grant (or cancel) by the institution as per norms
- Choose freeze or upgrade option with intimation to the institute

Documents required during application and physical document verification are listed (but not limited to) as Annexure-I.

The above instructions are subject to change. The final decision regarding all the processes of counselling and admission will be taken by the Directorate of Technical Education as and when necessary.

Anti Ragging

Institutions must follow the norms and regulations under notification number F.No.37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01-07-2009 of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)

Detailed guidelines to be followed in the entire Online Counselling process for admission to the Diploma Engineering & Technology for the session 2026-27 will be shared through the registration and application portal.

Candidates will have to produce for verification the following documents in original at the time of admission and submit the self-attested photocopies of the same along with 2 (two) recent passport-size photographs with their signature.
